

Snow Skiing

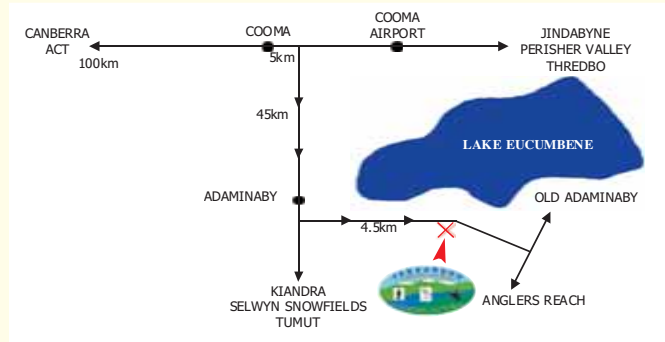
Winter Season
June through October

Selwyn Snowfields is situated 35 minutes drive from "Yaraandoo" and is the ideal snow recreational area for beginners and intermediates. It's the Winter playground all families can enjoy.



Families and groups can book the Homestead which is fully self contained. And linen is provided (except towels). All you need to bring is your food and beverages. On site manager in separate living quarters.

What to bring: "Yaraandoo" is fully self contained during the winter season. Guests will need to arrange all their own gear for skiing as well as food, beverages and personal items. There are several outlets for ski gear hire in Adaminaby as well as at Selwyn Snowfields. *N.B. During Winter all linen is provided except for towels.*



How to get here: From Canberra the Snowy Mountains Highway takes you about 100kms to Cooma. Drive through town heading south towards Jindabyne for 5 kms then take the first major turnoff to the right towards Kiandra, Tumut and Adaminaby. Drive for 45 kms which will get you to Adaminaby, the home of the "Big Trout". Continue through town towards Kiandra for about 1 kilometre and take the first turn to the left towards Old Adaminaby. Drive for about 4.5 kilometres until you come to "Yaraandoo" on the right hand side of the road and directly opposite Yens Bay, Lake Eucumbene.

Interstate and Overseas Guests:

From Sydney flight are available to Canberra or Cooma. Canberra airport is about 1.5-2 hrs drive and Cooma airport is about 40 minutes drive. Please contact us for further details.

Costs:

Winter Season – June through October.

The Homestead can be booked from A\$450 per night and sleeps up to 12 people.

Spring/Summer/Autumn Season – November through May

Yaraandoo Lakeside Retreat



The Homestead

“Yaraandoo” Lakeside Retreat is situated opposite Yens Bay on the shores of Lake Eucumbene in the Snowy Mountains and offers excellent accommodation for snow skiers as well as horse riding and trout fishing.



The Homestead sleeps up to 12 people in 3 double bedrooms, (2 with ensuites) and an open loft area with 6 beds and a VCR/DVD/Games system ideal for kids. The third main bathroom with spa bath is located on the ground floor. Living area with large open fire, TV/Stereo system, dining area and fully fitted modern kitchen with gas oven, combustion stove, microwave oven and dishwasher. Laundry, dryer and under floor heating. All linen is provided (except towels during Winter). Another feature of the homestead is the surrounding verandahs with spectacular views overlooking the lake and the outside BBQ area with wood burning fire pit as well as gas cooking.

Horse Riding

We provide quality horses and instruction with experienced guides for all levels. Morning and afternoon riding on thousands of acres with spectacular views of the lake and surrounding mountains.



What to bring: We suggest jeans or jodpurs with riding boots or smooth soled shoes. A warm jumper, coat, gloves and stockings can also come in handy as the weather can get cold and sun screen is a good idea for the high country air. We provide safety helmets and oil skins and your Aussie felt hat will keep the sun out of your eyes during the day and your ears warm around the fire at night.

Fishing

Lake Eucumbene is renowned for its trout fishing and visitors have several options to fish either with bait, lures or flies. We will happily give you guidance and advice on any of these options.



What to bring: Most fishing people like to bring their own gear, but we provide bait and lure rods for those who don't. Bait and lures can be purchased at the local tackle shops and other outlets in Adaminaby. We provide all gear for fly fishing lessons.
